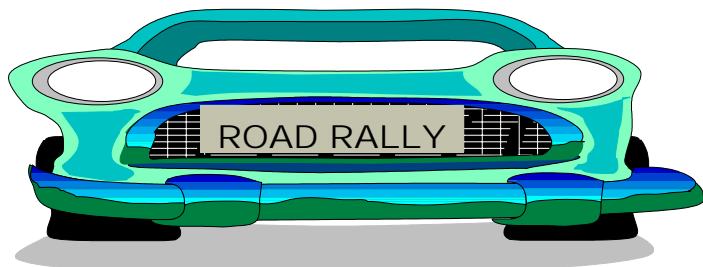

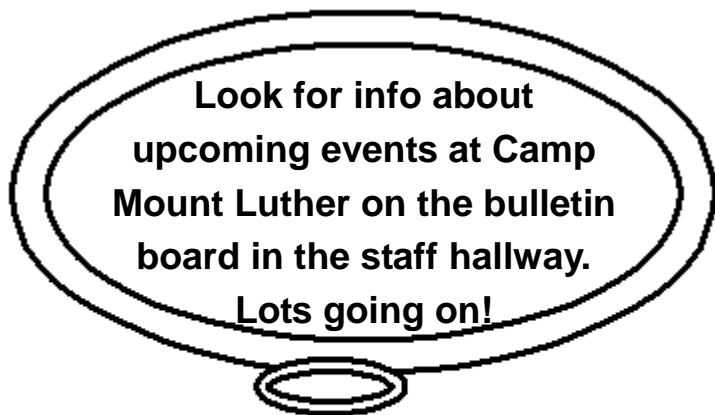


BOWLING, ANYONE?
