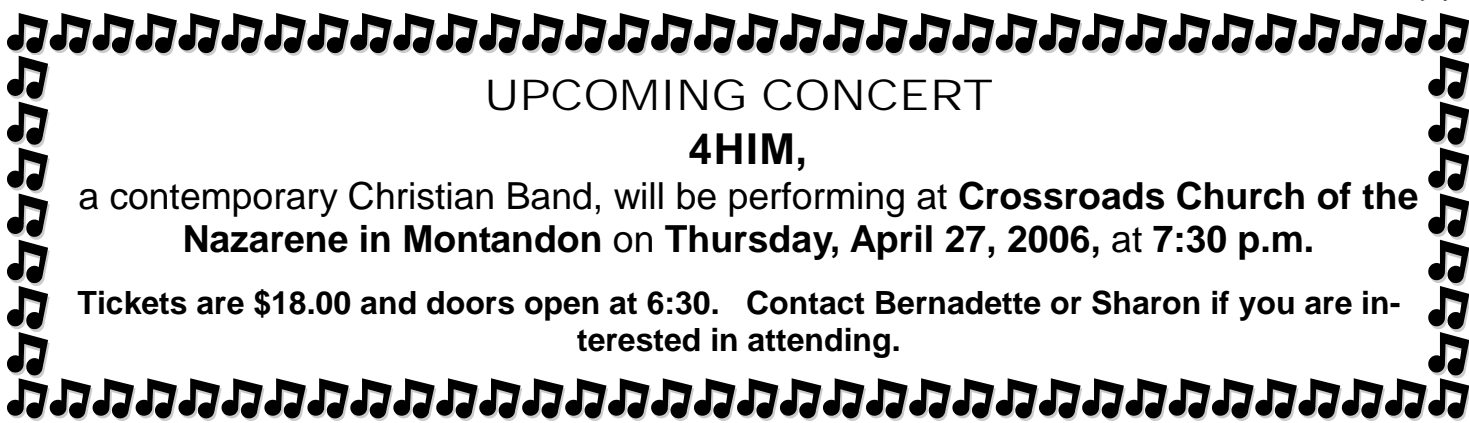

Elementary Floodlight:

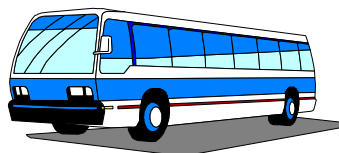

NEW WINDSOR TRIP

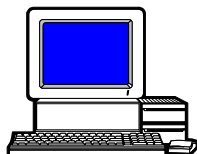
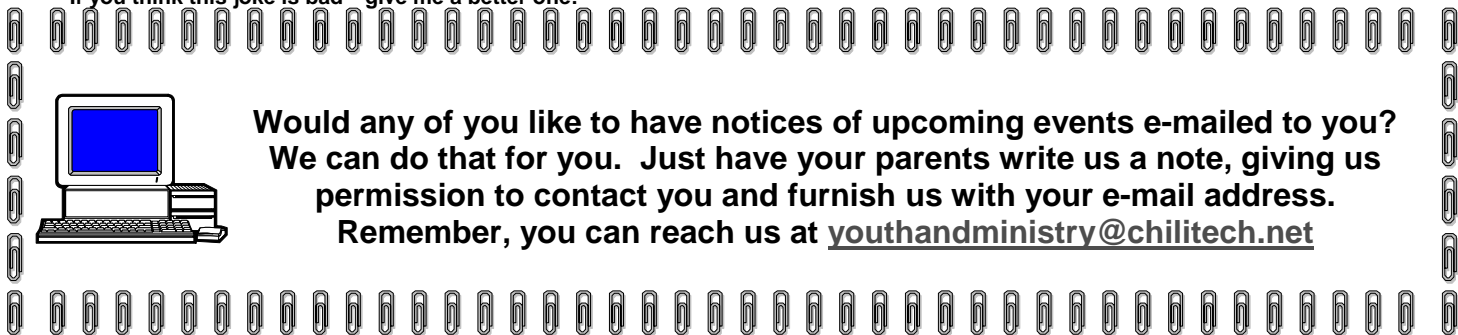
