An Order for the Blessing of Pets October 2, 2022 2:00 p.m. in the Afternoon St. Mark's Lutheran Church Williamsport, PA, 17701 Rev. Brian D. Vasey, Pastor



GATHERING

When most of the pets and their friends have gathered, the assembly forms a circle.

GREETING

The animals of God's creation inhabit the skies, the earth and the sea. They share in the fortunes of human existence and have a part in human life. God, who confers gifts on all living things, has often used the service of animals as reminders of the gifts of salvation. Animals were saved from the flood and afterwards made a part of the covenant with Noah. The paschal lamb recalls the passover sacrifice and the deliverance from slavery in Egypt. A giant fish saved Jonah. Ravens brought bread to Elijah. Animals were included in the repentance of Nineveh; and all creation shares in the redemption of Christ. Therefore, with thanksgiving, we invoke God's blessing on these animals gathered before us.

After each individual pet has been blessed, the following prayer is shared: As God has blessed you with these pets, so may they be blessed by your love and care; in the name of the Father, + and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.
