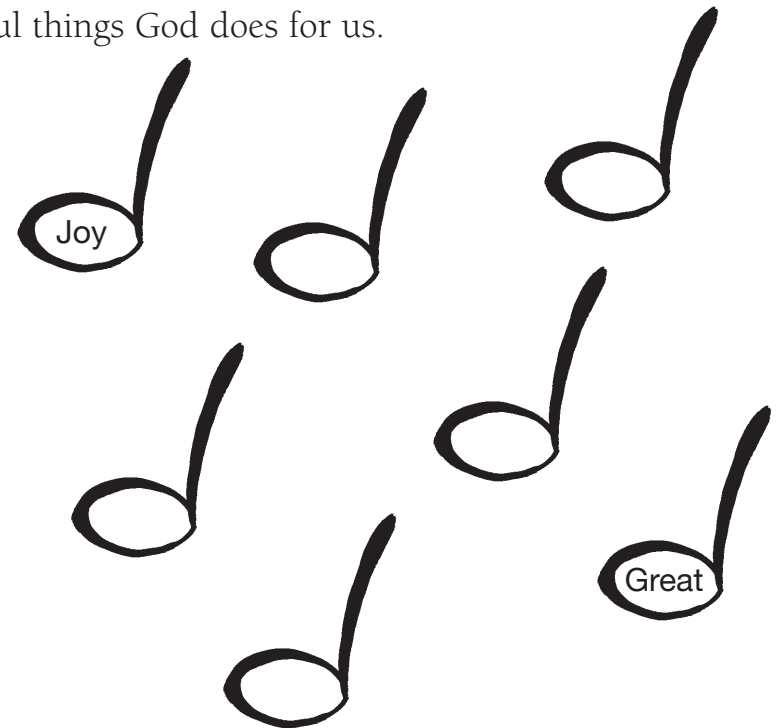

Psalm 67

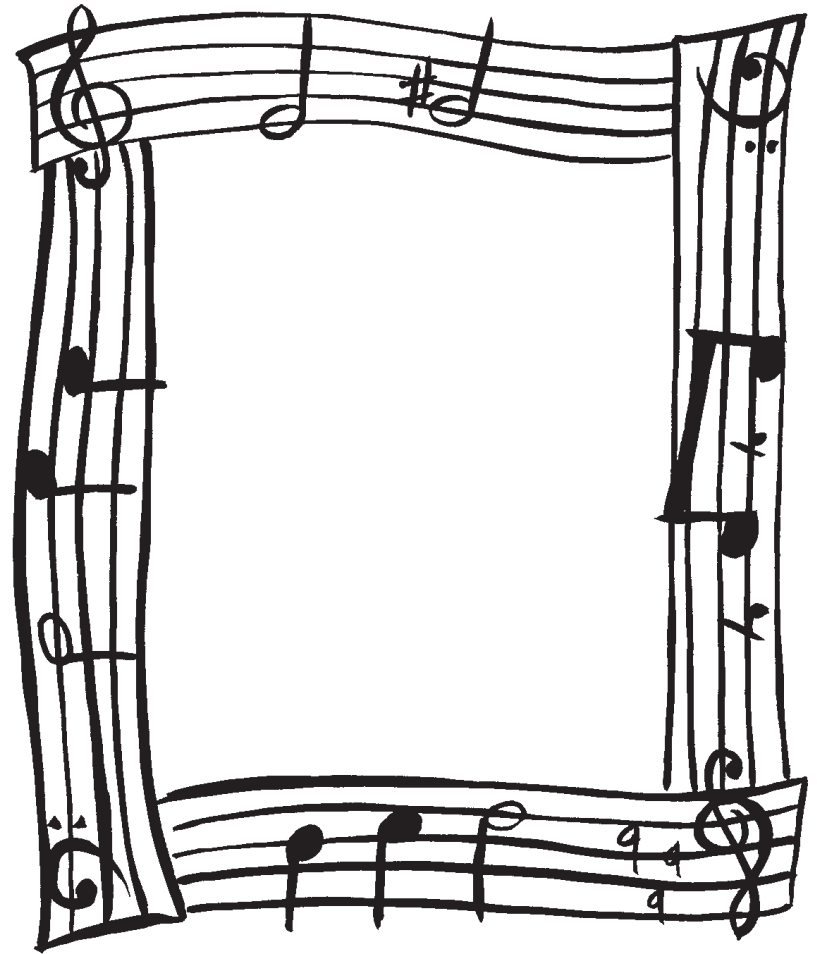
A psalm is a poem or song about God. The Bible has a whole book of psalms!
